Tour Itinerary

Uganda Safari 10 Days

Day 1:

Transfer to Murchison Falls National Park

Enjoy breakfast at your hotel in the morning and after proceed to Murchison falls National Park, you will drive through Luwero triangle and have a stopover at Zziwa Rhino sanctuary where the endangered rhinoceros are bred. This Rhino sanctuary was started to protect the White Rhino populations found in Uganda. Another stop will be in Masindi in order to enjoy your lunch and later continue to the park and proceed to the top of the falls which will give you fantastic views of the park.

You will see some wildlife by the roadside. Continue to the park to check in to your accommodation to relax for the Evening. Murchison falls has variety of wildlife species including; the lions, giraffes, leopards, civet, hyenas, elephants, buffalos, crocodiles, hippos and many bird species.

Day 2:

Morning game drive and a boat cruise along the Nile

Have breakfast early enough and after proceed to the park to engage in a morning game drive where you will be able to view many animals including the giraffes, lions, elephants, buffalos, birds etc. after the game drive, proceed to the lodge and enjoy your lunch as you prepare to have an afternoon boat cruise on the Nile River. This boat safari is said to be the highlight of the safari in Murchison falls since it allows you to get up close to the animal species with in the water. This river is said to harbor over 4000 hippos with many Nile crocodiles as well as birds including; the colored kingfishers, bee eaters, shoe billed stork etc. later return to the lodge for a relaxation in the evening.

Day 3:

Transfer to the 'Mountains of the Moon'

As you prepare to depart to Kibaale Forest national park, have early breakfast and drive to the top of the Falls. You will enjoy the powerful Nile as it squeezes through the narrow gorge producing beautiful rainbows. Drive to Kibaale Forest National Park, through the Albertine Escarpment of the Great Rift Valley. Stopover for hot lunch in Hoima town. Proceed to Fort Portal where you will Check-in to your accommodation. Freshen up and wait for your dinner to be served.

Day 4:

Chimpanzee Trekking Kibale, Transfer to Queen Elizabeth

In the morning you will have breakfast and transfer to Kibale forest national park Headquarters for briefing before setting off for a forest walk in search for chimpanzees. The forest walk will be guided to provide information not only on chimpanzees and primates but also on the entire park and surrounding communities making it interesting. The walk will reward you with other primates like baboons, Grey cheeked Mangabey, Colobus monkeys, Red-tailed. After chimp tracking, return to the lodge, freshen up and prepare for the swamp walk / cultural walk through the surrounding villages. Return to the lodge and wait for your dinner to be served.

Day 5:

Morning game drive and an afternoon boat cruise

Begin your day with an early breakfast, check out of your lodge and proceed to Queen Elizabeth National Park. Have lunch and brief rest before heading to the Kazinga Channel for an afternoon boat cruise in the sunset. You will see hippos, buffaloes, crocodiles, elephants, water bucks, warthogs and many other wildlife at the banks as well as plenty of bird species as Queen Elizabeth has the highest number of bird species in Uganda's national game parks. Retire to back to your lodge and enjoy the beautiful sunset as you wait for your dinner.

Day 6:

Tree Climbing Lions, Transfer to Bwindi

Begin the day with early breakfast, have a morning game drive to view plenty of wildlife before proceeding to the Ishasha Sector; this takes you through the unique western rift valley escarpment; in search of tree climbing lions. Have a stopover for hot lunch at Savannah Resort Hotel in Kihiihi. Thereafter, go through the winding hills as you climb to higher altitudes, home to the mountain gorillas. The journey will take you approximately four hours depending on the weather. Check-in to your accommodation late in the evening and freshen up as you wait for your dinner.

Day 7: Gorilla Trekking in Bwindi

Have an early breakfast 6:30am, then proceed to the park headquarters by 7.30am for a briefing from the Park Wardens. Ensure to carry along rain jacket, drinking water, snacks, ankle high jungle boots. The park wardens will allocate you different gorilla families which you will track. The park rangers will lead you inside the jungle to see the shy Primates for a group you have been booked for. Do not forget to take your lunch boxes and all the necessary gear to track the rare Mountain Gorilla, perhaps one of the most exciting wildlife experiences on earth. The tracking may take between 2 and 8 hours but it's well worth the effort. The afternoon is spent on a village walk which gives you a great opportunity to see how the people surrounding Bwindi Impenetrable Forest live. It also is a great way to support the local community in a direct way. The Walk begins with your guide at your lodge and is most informative, rewarding to the average visitor. It will amaze you how resourceful the local people are as you see and learn their ways. The cultural excursion will showcase art and craft, dance and culture as well as way of life if you have time you can learn a few skills yourself.

Day 8: Transfer to Lake Bunyonyi, Adventure Park

After breakfast head for another Adventure safari at Lake Bunyonyi. On arrival you will check in at your choice of accommodation. Have a boat cruise to the beautiful Islands on this lake as you enjoy the abundant bird life here. It is for this reason that this lake is referred to as 'Bunyonyi' a local word for the outstandingly big number of birds here. You may have some cultural entertainment by the Bakiga including dances. Enjoy a community walk to accustom yourself with the local culture and practices of the native Bakiga – Banyangezi people. This community is very friendly with great hospitality. You may purchase some handicrafts which are actually locally made by the residents of this area. In the afternoon head over to the Supreme Adventure Park for High ropes and zip lining over the Lake as well as canoeing. Swimming is recommended in this lake as its free of Bilharzia. Dine and slumber at your preferred lodge.

Day 9:

Transfer to Lake Mburo National Park, Afternoon Boat Cruise

A relaxed breakfast and later start our journey to Lake Mburo National park heading East through Mbarara town known as “the land of Milk and Honey” You will have lunch in this beautiful town of Mbarara. From here you will head to Lake Mburo Uganda’s small picturesque safari park famous for its Zebras and herds of antelopes. Check in at your lodge then a boat cruise to the eastern bank of the park in the afternoon. While this cruise, expect to see huge crocodile sun bathing, hippos swimming, birdwatching, as well as other wild animal like Impala, Buffaloes, Elands and Zebras. Return to your lodge for dinner and overnight at your preferred lodge.

Day 10:

Morning Game Drive, Cultural Tour, Departure

This last day of your stay will start with breakfast a game drive before your journey back to Kampala. While the game drive you will encounter a number of bird species, Impalas, Elands, buffalo, zebras and many more. Have lunch at Igongo Cultural Center, followed by a tour of the cultural museum. Thereafter, travel to Kampala with a stopover at the equator for pictures and craft shopping. Arriving Kampala in the evening to mark the end of the tour.
