

Gorillas & Lake Bunyonyi 4 Days

Day 1:

Transfer from Kampala to Bwindi National Park

Your guide will pick you up from your accommodation and drive from Kampala heading southwest via the Kampala Masaka Mbarara highway. Have a stop at Nabusanke to take some photos at the equator crossing and later have lunch in Mbarara at the Igongo Cultural Center. You will drive on to Bwindi impenetrable national park. This park is home to the internationally renowned endangered mountain gorillas a unique feature for the tourism industry of Uganda. Bwindi national park, plus Mgahinga National Park together with the Volcanoes Park in Rwanda and the Virunga Volcanoes of Congo home to the world's surviving endangered mountain gorillas. Dine and slumber at your preferred lodge. Dinner is served from 6pm to 9pm

Day 2:

Gorilla Trekking in Bwindi Impenetrable National Park

Have an early breakfast 6:30am, then proceed to the park headquarters by 7.30am for a briefing from the Park Wardens. Ensure to carry along rain jacket, drinking water, snacks, ankle high jungle boots. The park wardens will allocate you different gorilla families which you will track. The park rangers will lead you inside the jungle to see the shy Primates for a group you have been booked for. Do not forget to take your lunch boxes and all the necessary gear to track the rare Mountain Gorilla, perhaps one of the most exciting wildlife experiences on earth. The tracking may take between 2 and 8 hours but it's well worth the effort. The afternoon is spent on a village walk which gives you a great opportunity to see how the people surrounding Bwindi Impenetrable Forest live. It also is a great way to support the local community in a direct way. The Walk begins with your guide at your lodge and is most informative, rewarding to the average visitor. It will amaze you how resourceful the local people are as you see and learn their ways. The cultural excursion will showcase art and craft, dance and culture as well as way of life if you have time you can learn a few skills yourself. You will see several souvenir shops, schools, churches and drinking joints. other option includes taking the trails, to see the stunning waterfalls plus the great profusion of birdlife in the forest plus the bird species in addition to various primates



Tour Itinerary

Gorillas & Lake Bunyonyi 4 Days

Day 3:

Lake Bunyonyi, Kabale

In the morning after a hefty breakfast you will depart from this mountain gorillas' sanctuary and drive to Lake Bunyonyi which is another primary tourist stopover which is outstandingly very marvelous. Bunyonyi is a local word for "small birds" in reference to the several birds that live around here making it a favorite destination for birders. You will be able to see several small islands among other highlights here. On arrival you will have a canoe ride you will see the various small islands such as Bwama Island also a wonderful destination for birders. Alternatively, you could take a nature walk which will help you to appreciate a great diversity of small birds here. End the day by visiting Bunyonyi Adventure Park for high ropes, zip lining over the lake. Swimming is recommended in this lake as its free of Bilharzia. Checkin, dine and slumber at your preferred lodge.

Day 4:

Transfer to Kampala/Entebbe

After breakfast walk towards the northern end of Lake Bunyonyi to the stunning Ruvuma swamp, one of the finest destinations to appreciate birds like the papyrus yellow warbler. Thereafter, head back to Kampala where this trip will end.





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
